

PJRFSI Releases 2.0 Versions of its own Cannabis and Hemp GMP/GACP Standards

Perry Johnson Registrars Food Safety, Inc. (PJRFSI) has officially released revised 2.0 versions of its own Good Manufacturing Practice (GMP) and Good Agriculture & Collection Practice (GACP) based Cannabis and Hemp Safety Standards. These certification standards originally developed by PJRFSI in 2020 are schemes intended to help cannabis and hemp growers, manufacturers, and retailers satisfy the range of requirements demanded not only by governing bodies but by consumers as well.

The standards aim to provide needed outlines for cultivation and product manufacture, transport and storage practices nationwide. As each state determines the status of cannabis and hemp product legality within their jurisdiction, certification requirements can be haphazard. With the development of their standard and their ANAB-accredited status, PJRFSI hopes to simplify and unite the United States hemp and cannabis industries for the benefit of everyone from grower to producer to end user.
