Strengthening Organic Enforcement: An Overview

- **Comprehensive Coverage:** The rule extends to all entities engaged in organic production and handling, emphasizing the need for certification for a majority, with limited exemptions, thus broadening the scope of oversight.
- **Import Certificates:** A notable requirement is the NOP Import Certificate for organic products entering the United States, ensuring an electronic and verifiable trail from the point of origin to the domestic market.
- **Organic Certification Process:** Detailed steps to certification underscore the commitment to maintaining organic standards across the supply chain, from choosing a USDA-accredited certifier to the issuance of an operation certificate.
- **Fraud Prevention:** The introduction of mandatory fraud prevention plans for certified operations reflects a proactive approach to safeguarding organic integrity against fraudulent practices.
- **Exemptions Clarified:** While the rule outlines exemptions, it underscores the responsibility of exempt operations to uphold organic standards and documentation requirements, promoting accountability across the board.
